

Storage tent 3,3x6x2,4m PVC

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Safety Advice

Attention

In some countries approval is needed to set up a tent larger than 75 m2.

The owner of the tent has the sole responsibility to make sure that these local rules are followed and that the mounting is correct.

In case of bad weather conditions, it is your responsibility to ensure that people inside are safe and that the tent does not cause damage to others.

Do not use open fire, welding equipment or other ignition sources in the tent. Though the fabric is made of flame retardant material it can still burn.

It is always recommended that you secure your tent properly with safety straps and augers when you put up the structure.

We recommend you to insure the tent, or check if it is covered by home contents insurance, in case of unplanned events, accidents or bad weather.


Tents are meant as temporary shelter and must be evacuated under extreme weather conditions.

This structure is not tested for specific snow and wind loads. That's why we always recommend to remove snow from the top.


Assembly with more than one person suggested. Please use gloves when assembling the metal frame portion of this unit. The metal components of this product have been treated with a rust preventive coating that may feel oily to the touch. This coating is not dangerous, but may dirty your hands during assembly. We recommend that you wipe metal parts clean with a mixture of warm water and dish detergent prior to assembly. Should your hands become dirty, simply wash with soap and water.

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 d) Repeat step c) until the whole shelter is completed. e) Make sure the base is open to 10' 8"". f) Make sure the distances AD and BC have exactly the same length as per illustration, lengths depends on the model. 	
 5. Cover installation (Ties are always on the inside) a) Place the roof in front of the shelter as illustrated. b) Unfold as illustrated then lift onto shelter as is. c) Place cover over the completed structure making sure that the TRIANGLE is at the front of the garage. d) Lace rope through grommets and around pipes tightly going completely around the garage. Grommets are placed in the upper corner of each door. Put the remaining cord through these grommets and secure to the ground with nails. e) Tie firmly inside ties to bars. 	
 6. Door Assembly a) Take one door with shiny side facing outside placing on to hooks (No.17). b) Repeat a) for the remaining doors. c) Take the elastic, put it through one of the grommet holes on the door from the inside out. Take S hook, place it on the elastic and squeeze one end with a pair of pliers so it locks on the elastic. Repeat until all the elastics are done, and then use the open end to hook on the grommet band of the roof. 	A P
 7. Anchoring garage. a) Place your garage in the final position you want then close the doors, front and back if supplied before anchoring, anchor with brackets (No.14) and nail (No.13) as per diagram on the first page. Drive anchor into ground. b) Fix flap to your house (if applicable). 	

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
