# Manual

The inflatable arched tents are available in many different sizes and designs. In this manual we have assumed an inflatable tent without a fixed ground sheet.

## SETTING UP

1. Take the tent out of the bag, roll and unfold it.
2. There are valves at both ends of each hose (on the inside). Make sure the drain nipples are closed.
3. Make sure the ends of the hoses are connected by the spacer straps supplied. These provide the round shape in the tent. If you have opted for a tent with a fixed ground sheet, these tires will not be supplied.
4. Now lay the first hose in a round arc on the canvas and connect the pump nipple of the spray gun to the valve of the tent. Pump up the hose to a maximum of 4 bar.
5. First lift the hose by hand and then use the guy rope already mounted in the center of the hose to lift the hose. Secure the line with a peg in the ground, to a heavy object, or have someone hold the guy line (Photo 1).
6. Apply approx. 0.5 bar into the next hose.
7. Remove an adjustable tension pole from the pole bag and tighten it properly between both hoses. After tensioning you can mount the straps around the pole to prevent the pole from falling out (photo 2).
8. Pump up the hose further to a maximum of 4 bar. While pumping, you can guide the hose to its semicircular shape.
9. Now pump up the next hose to approx. 0.5 bar and repeat the previous actions.
10. After the entire tent has been erected, you can tighten the rest of the tension poles firmly between the hoses. Here too you can then mount the straps.
11. Make sure the tent has a nice semicircular shape (photo 3).
12. Always tension the pre-assembled guy ropes as far from the tent as possible. This prevents the tent from becoming unstable in light to moderate wind.

## **BREAKING DOWN**

10. Relax all guy lines.
11. Remove the tensioning straps from the poles and remove the tensioning poles. Do not remove the center sticks in the ridge yet.
12. Unscrew the valve cap on both ends of the rear hose. Once there is enough air out of the hose and the hose starts to collapse, you can remove the center stick.
13. Now let the air out of the penultimate hose and remove the next stick. Repeat these operations until all hoses are empty.
14. Lay the tent flat on the ground and fold the excess cloth to one side. Let as much air out of the hoses as possible (Photo 4).
15. Beat the right side about 40 cm. Om (photo 5).
16. Fold the left side so that the bottom of the boards are against each other (photo 5).
17. Now fold the whole thing in half one more time and roll up the package firmly and put it in the bag.

## **IMPORTANT**

- Always make sure the tent is completely dry before it stays in the bag for an extended period of time. If the tent is damp or is stored in a damp room, mold will quickly form.
- The inflatable tents are very wind resistant if they are set up correctly, so always hand the instructions.
- Ensure regular checks if the arch tent is standing for a longer period of time. Check the pressure and tension of the hoses, guy ropes and tension poles several times a week.
- Use in extreme weather conditions and wind force 7 or higher at your own risk.
- Repairs to your product cannot be carried out in June, July & August.
- You have a quality product purchased on which we provide a 12-month warranty on material and construction defects.
